I have a family or background in the Czech Republic

If you have a family or some background in the Czech Republic, you can come to the Czech Republic based on visa-free travel. After that you can apply for a **special long-term visa** at the Ministry of the Interior.

I have no background in the Czech Republic

If you do not have any contacts in the Czech Republic and you cannot afford accommodation, you can contact the Ministry of the Interior Infoline. The Infoline will answer your questions and help you solve your situation. It is also possible to come to the Vyšní Lhota Registration Humanitarian Center.

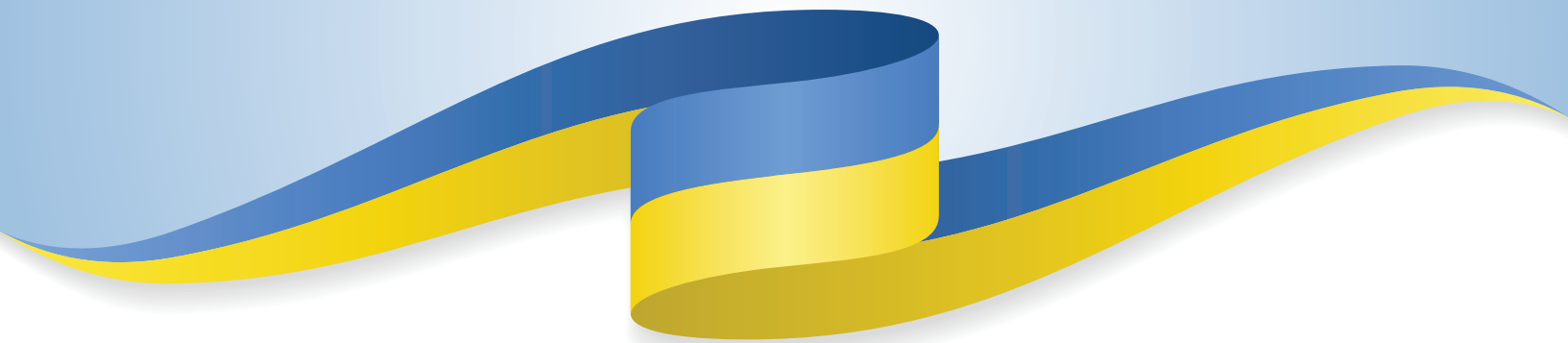

It is possible to arrive and stay in the Czech Republic for a period of 90 days without a visa, but only on the basis of a valid biometric passport.
